 - ▶ 85% of sonographers surveyed rated the system a "9" or "10"
- 2. On a scale 1 to 10 (10 being excellent), please rank the image quality of VidiStar.
 - ▶ 77% of sonographers surveyed said VidiStar's image quality ranks between an "8" and "10"
- 3. The Vidistar platform has helped improve my workflow.
