

## CONTROL PANEL





- (a) Grab Tab click arrow to open/close Control Panel.
- **(b) Mute** By default, attendees are muted (in listen-only mode) to minimize background noises.
- (c) View in full screen mode

#### Distributions of Provider Relief Fund ("PRF")

3 Phases of Distributions and Targeted Distributions

#### **Terms and Conditions**

- "...the Payment will only be used to <u>prevent</u>, <u>prepare for</u>, <u>and respond</u> to coronavirus, and that the Payment shall reimburse the Recipient only for <u>health care related expenses or lost revenues</u> that are attributable to coronavirus."
- "The Recipient shall <u>submit reports</u> as the Secretary determines are needed to ensure compliance with conditions that are imposed on this Payment, and such reports shall be <u>in such form</u>, <u>with such content</u>, as specified by the Secretary in <u>future program instructions</u> directed to all Recipients."

## Reporting Requirements







Applicable to anyone who received one or more payments exceeding \$10,000 in the aggregate





Additional six-month extension to June 30, 2021 to use remaining amounts



## Who reports?



Entity (at the TIN level) that received one or more PRF payments, OR An entity that meets all of the following three criteria:



Parent of one or more subsidiary billing TINs that received General Distribution Payments



Has providers associated with it that were providing diagnoses, testing, or care for individuals with possible or actual cases of COVID-19 on or after January 31, 2020



An entity that can otherwise attest to the Terms and Conditions





## Healthcare Related Expenses Attributable to Coronavirus





#### Two categories:


- General and Administrative Expenses (G&A)
- Other Healthcare Related Expenses

Recipients of \$10,000 - \$499,999 in aggregate must report the above two categories

Recipients of at least \$500,000 in aggregate must report more detailed information based on subcategories


# Subcategories of General and Administrative Expenses

Lost revenues up to the amount of the difference between 2019 and 2020 actual patient care revenue




### Lost Revenues







Negative change in year-overyear actual revenue from patient care related sources



Includes all lost patient care revenues and patient care cost/expense impacts

Reporting System opens for providers



February 15, 2021

First reporting deadline for all providers on use of funds

July 13, 2021

Final reporting deadline for providers who did not fully expend PRF funds prior to December 31, 2020
