Electrophysiology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tilt Table Tests • ILR implants • Pacemaker implant for sinus node dysfunction, Mobitz I AV block, or tachy-brady syndrome in mildly symptomatic patients. • Primary Prevention ICD • Pacemaker/ICD generator change outs in patients with >6 weeks battery remaining. • Atrial fib and atrial flutter ablations in patients who are not at risk of being hospitalized by delaying the procedure • SVT ablations • PVC ablations • Watchman implants • Lead extractions in non-infected patients, unless device function is dependent on lead extraction and reimplant. • Outpatient Cardioversions in rate controlled patients 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inpatient pacemaker and ICD implants • Inpatient ablations • Inpatient Cardioversions • Outpatient Cardioversions in patients who cannot be rate controlled or highly symptomatic • Outpatient pacemaker or ICD implants for complete heart block, Mobitz II AV block, or highly symptomatic bradycardia or arrhythmias • Lead extractions for infected patients or lead fracture/malfunction that requires replacement for device function • VT ablations • Atrial fib/flutter ablations in patients who cannot be rate controlled • Pacemaker/ICD generator change out with <6 weeks battery remaining
